

Sale of Hamess 5782/2022

The power of selling any and all articles of *Hamess* left during the Passover Holiday must be delegated to the Rabbi who, in turn, will sell it to a non-Jew for you. This sale can definitely not be transacted by the ordinary layman as the procedure is complicated and must, therefore, be arranged only by a Rabbi. The Rabbi should be contacted a few days in advance. Any *Hamess* retained for use after Pesah can not be eaten or sold, unless it was sold before Pesah, through a Rabbi.
